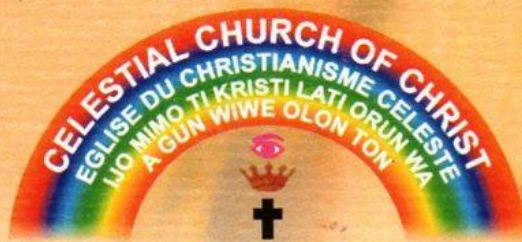

**Memorandum #8**

It is regrettably observed that a number of parishes are still being run as personal estates or personal grocery stores without any regard for the operating System or the Administrative Mechanism established for the proper, cohesive, and disciplined functioning of the diocese. Meetings and organized forum scheduled for the education, information and development of parishes are ignored with impudence by a few shepherds who feel puffed off in rejection of further development and growth in knowledge.

Please note that, henceforth, your parish shall not be acknowledged or recognized unless the following mandatory imports are observed and complied with.

1. Your Parish and its leadership must recognized the state supervisor, the regional supervisor, and diocesan office and fully cooperate with the directives and guidance emanating from these offices.
2. The shepherd and the parish must fully and effectively identify with every meeting of the state/region/diocese.
3. The shepherd must fully participate in every training and refresher courses that may be organized for the improvement and enhancement of knowledge and awareness.
4. The parish must be administered strictly according to the tenets and doctrines of Celestial Church of Christ as delivered through the Rev. Pastor and founder of the Church, and the administration should strictly conform with the Provisions of USA Diocese Bye-Laws.
5. The Pastoral Mission Fund is mandatory for every parish.
6. Members of the Directorate of Inspection may visit your parish without prior notice and observe the entire atmosphere and general conduct. They may recommend citation over violations of ordinances and good conduct.

7. Submission of statistics on number of members, birth, baptism, marriages, graduations, and death to your state secretariat quarterly for onward transmission to the Regional and finally diocesan Secretariat.
8. Your harvest Program must observe and comply with the approved harvest Template: after the picture of the state supervisor comes the picture of the shepherd and NOT the shepherd and his wife. If you need to show your wife's picture in the program it should be towards the end of the program and Not aligned with those of the clergies.
9. The diocese will no longer encourage or approve any unreasonable breakup of any parish for the formation of another parish under any guise or excuse. Before any parish can be established henceforth, the feasibility Study and application sponsored by seven different families must have been approved by the State Council, Regional Council, and diocese. It shall be in a virgin zone of no less than 45 minutes - 60 minutes driving distance to an existing parish, and shall be in total compliance with the Policy Paper on Establishment of Parishes, unless there is an exceptional .


Please note that unless all the above obligation are fully complied with, the diocese, region and state will not:

- I. Recognize that offending parish.
- II. Officiate at any celebration in such non-complying parish.
- III. Promote the harvest or any activities of such non-conforming parish.
- IV. Recognize and recommend such parish for anointment exercise.
- V. Recognize such parish for Pastoral visits.
- VI. Reflect the name of such parish in the Directory of USA Diocese.
- VII. Will ostracize such parish from appointments and the common goal of the diocese.

It is important to recognize that unless we are all drinking from a common Fountain of knowledge, understanding, and training there is bound to continue the current inverse correlation in practice and discipline among parishes, thereby, perpetuating further the present poor corporate image of the church.

The cooperation of all is strongly solicited to move this Church to the next critical level of International recognition.
